The churches we have visited in the last few months have been such a blessing to us. Thanks to each of you for the great times of fellowship and your support. The various ways we have shared were all special times.

Just so you know, this process is difficult and a lot

of work. But it will be worth it all! We had our “last” garage sale early in October. The \$1,700 we made brought our total to over \$4,000 from 5 garage sales this year. We are so grateful for God's grace and blessing during these sales. We still have things to get rid of when we move, but we have made huge strides! Plus, now the house looks ready to sell!

Currently, we are targeting February/March 2010 for our move to Ukraine, once we have our house sold and our budget raised.

share our heart with your church. Please let your Pastor know what we are doing and ask them about having us come and share. Even if your church is not prepared to support us financially, we would still be willing to come and share with you what God has placed in our hearts.
